Headlines: 12 Month Prescriptions

Recent updates to prescribing regulations indicate that certain patients may qualify for prescriptions extending beyond three months. Looking ahead, we expect that a GP review will be required when it's time for your repeat prescription. Consequently, our existing method of processing repeat prescriptions through the script line will be phased out in the coming months. We encourage you to call now and schedule your GP review to ensure you don't run out of your medications.
